Edmonton... The Edmonton Arts Council and Toronto Arts Council will co-host a summit of 50 leaders from Canada's arts sector, on April 24 and 25 in Edmonton, addressing the topic 'How do we speak for the arts in Canada today?'

Participants in the summit are representative of the diverse range of perspectives and activities within the arts sector, and include artists, arts administrators, representatives from funding and service organizations, and academics.
