This Sunday, **January 8**, the city's music veterans of past and present **The Trocadero Orchestra** will deliver the 'swing' with music of the glory years of Big Band era. For those not on skates, dancing inside City Hall is encouraged with the friendly help of **Sugar Swing Dance Club**. They will be on site to offer free swing dance lessons to those with two left feet—they believe everyone can dance!
